INTRODUCTION

What kind of School is Haydon?

- Haydon is an Academy School, which means that responsibility for admissions rests with the Governing Body. **Applications are therefore made directly to the school.**
- Haydon is a Language College and Applied Learning Specialist School. It specialises in teaching a wide range of modern foreign languages, and applied learning courses as well as providing excellent teaching in all other subjects.
- Haydon is a mixed comprehensive school, which welcomes students of all abilities from 11 to 18 years old.

APPLYING FOR A PLACE

- The application form should be placed in an envelope marked '**ADMISSIONS**', together with two stamped, addressed envelopes each measuring (23cm x 16cm) A5 size, and sent to:

- The first of the two envelopes will be used to confirm that the school has received the application. Please contact the school if you do not receive this acknowledgement. The second will be used to inform parents of the result of their application.

SUMMARY OF THE ADMISSIONS CRITERIA:

1. CHILDREN IN PUBLIC CARE:

- Priority is given to children in public care

2. SIBLINGS:

- Students who **currently** have a brother or sister at Haydon.

3. GEORGRAPHY:

- Students who live nearest to the school measured in a straight line from the school to the front door of their parents' permanent home.

4. LANGUAGE

- Students who wish to specialise in languages at AS and A level. Students will be expected to apply for two languages. Students in this category will not be allowed to drop a language or change from a language to another subject throughout the AS course in Year 12

YEAR 12 (SIXTH FORM) ADMISSIONS

- The admission limit for Year 12 for [2012-2013](#) is 300 students.

Applying for a Place

- Haydon welcomes applications to join the Sixth Form both from its own students and from students at other schools.
- The closing date for applications to join the Sixth Form is **noon on [Friday 3 February 2012](#)**.

Admissions and Course Entry Requirements

Internal and External Applicants

- Admission to the Sixth Form is subject to satisfactory reports in Year 11, with specific reference to attendance, punctuality and effort grades.
- There must be a course available to an applicant from which he or she would benefit.
- If they meet the criteria students in Year 11 at Haydon will be offered a place in the Sixth Form before external applicants.

External Applicants Only

The Approved Admission Number to Year 12 in [2012](#) is 300. In the event of the number of applicants wishing to join Year 12 by [Friday 3 February 2012](#) exceeding the limit outlined above, The Admissions Criteria will be followed, in the order shown will be used to decide which external applicants are offered a place

1. Students who wish to specialise in languages at AS and A level. Students will be expected to apply for two languages. Students in this category will not be allowed to drop a language or change from a language to another subject throughout the AS course in Year 12.
 - The qualifying address for this criterion will be the student's permanent home with his/her parents on 3 [February 2012](#).

Admission to Specific Courses

The minimum entry requirement for A & AS levels is 6 GCSE grades A*-C, which would normally include grade Cs in English Language and Mathematics, in 5 or more subjects. In addition, it is highly desirable for a student to have a grade C in any subject which he or she wishes to continue from GCSE to AS and/or A level. Please note there are specific criteria required for A-level Maths, Modern Foreign Languages and Sciences. These are outlined in the Sixth Form Prospectus
