We feel that it is important that all students fully understand what is required of them to ensure that they obtain the maximum benefit from the next two years.

Finally the Sixth Form is open to all students as long as they have shown a commitment to the school and met the criteria outlined above as well as achieving the academic criteria detailed in the Sixth Form Prospectus.
