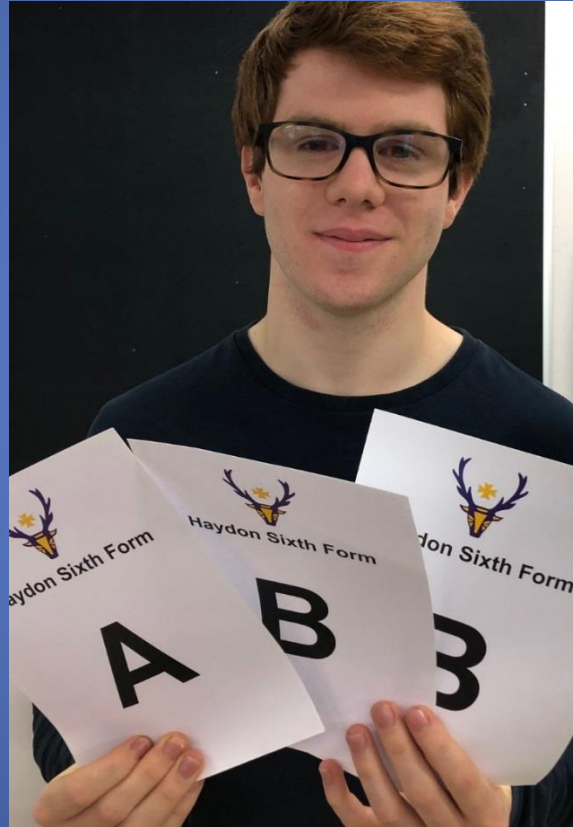

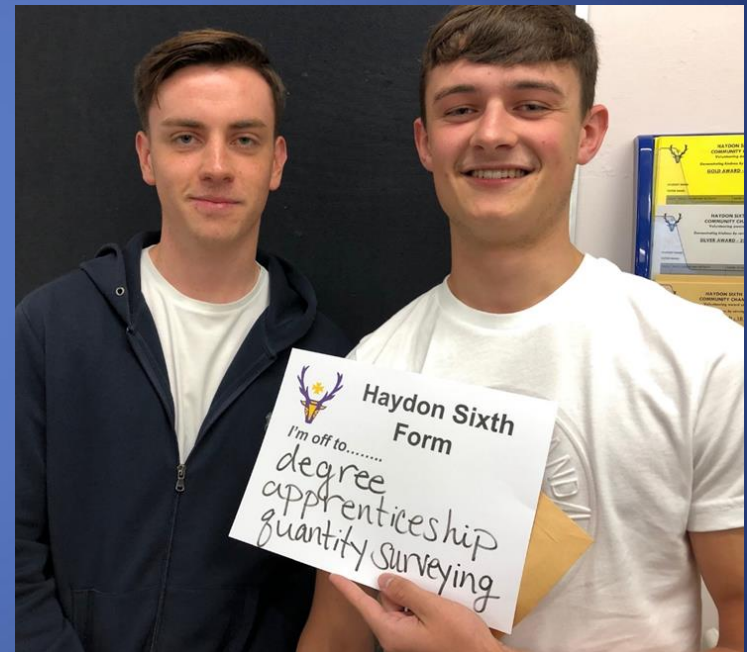

# ABCD of a Successful student



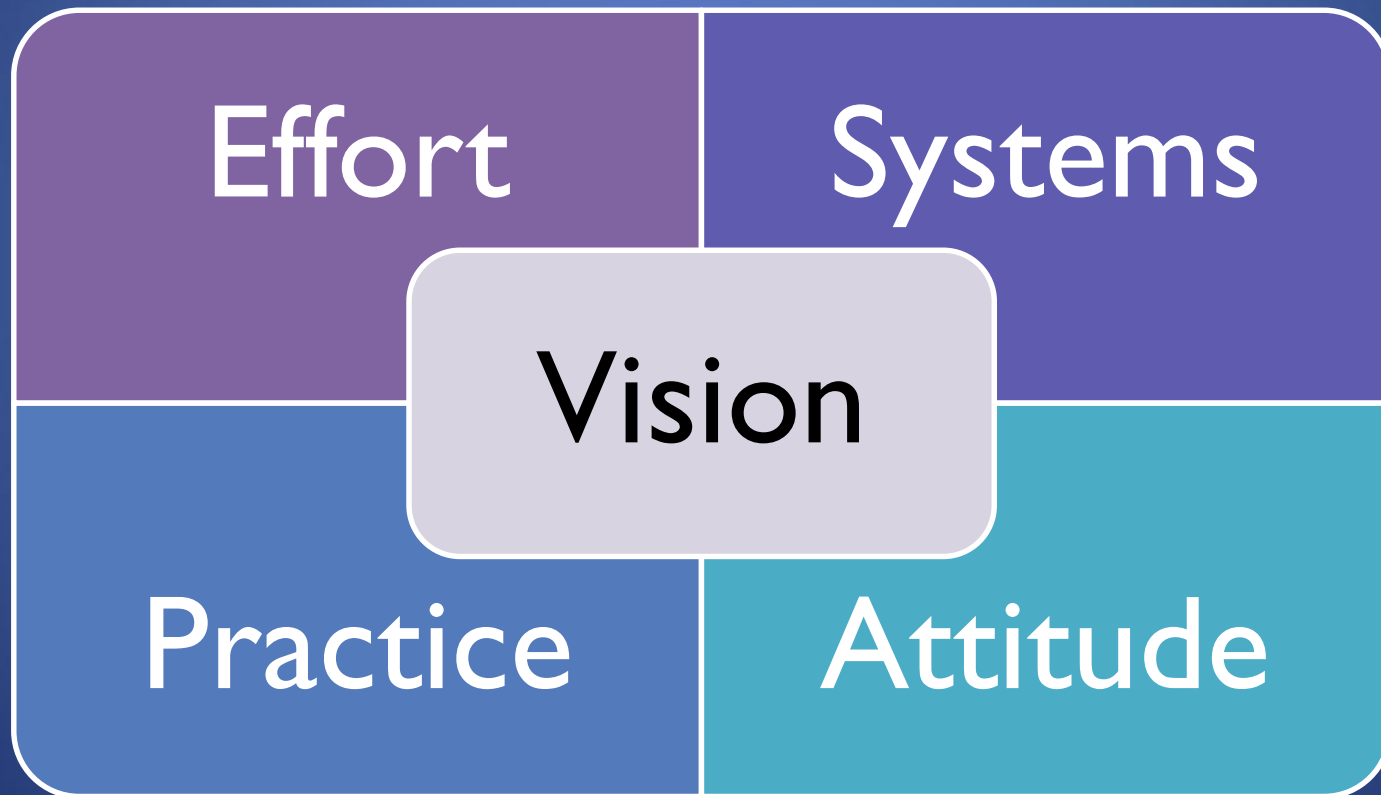
**Attendance** - It is expected that your attendance will be above 95%. It is one of the keys to attainment.
