 - Are you **SAFE** in everything you do



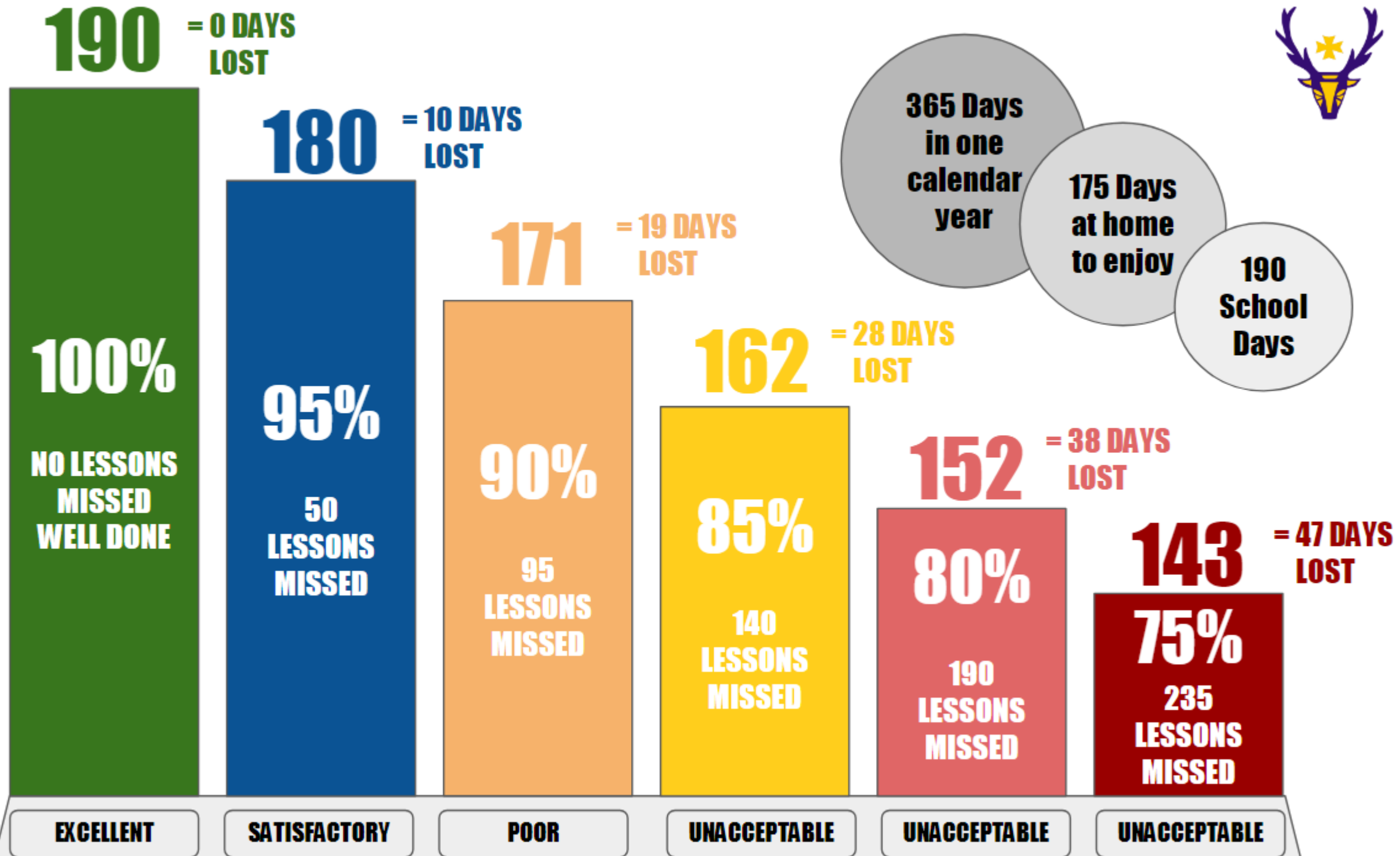
