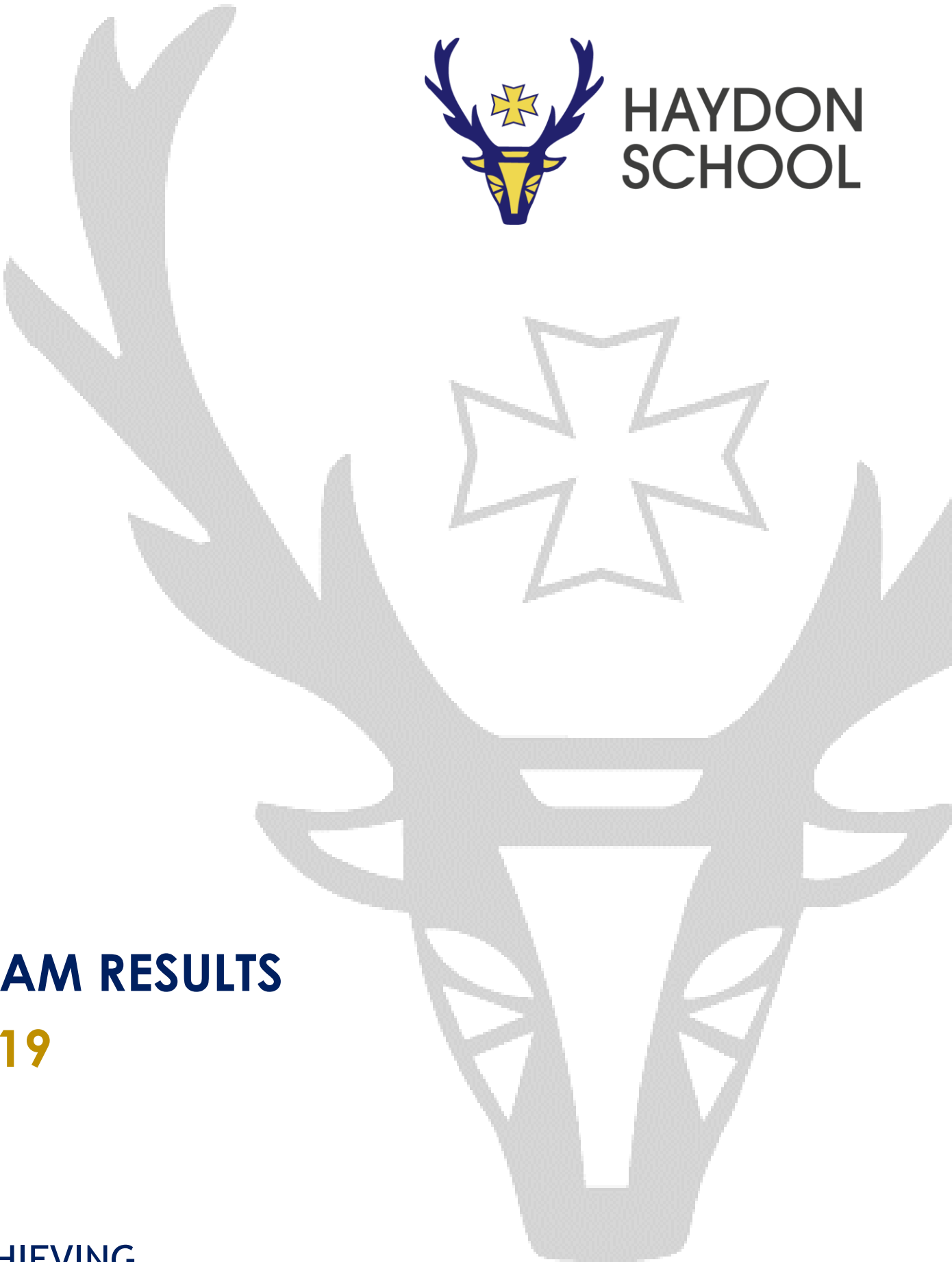

It is with great pleasure and pride in our students and staff that I introduce the examination results for 2019. Once again, our students have performed extremely well at GCSE and A-level and I would like to congratulate all of the students in Years 11 and 13. It gives me a real sense of pride seeing the youngsters rewarded for their hard work and successfully moving on to the next stage of their lives.

Year 11

This year there were new GCSE examinations in many subjects and now most subjects are graded on the 9 to 1 scale.

10% of all GCSE grades were 9 or 8.

88 students achieved at least one top grade (8 or 9)

20.1% of GCSE grades were graded 9 to 7

51 students achieved 5 or more grades at 7 or above

55.4% of GCSE grades were graded 9 to 5.

The government has introduced new measures of accountability for schools. At Haydon School 70% of students got a standard pass (Grade 4 or higher) in English and mathematics and 44% got a good pass in both English and mathematics (Grade 5 or higher).



Year 13

At A-level, examinations are changing and the vast majority are now assessed at the end of the second year. The Year 13 A-level results were very good: 37.5% of grades were at A* to B and 61.2% at A* to C. I have recently received the report from UCAS on the destinations of our Year 13 students going to university: 134 Haydon School students are looking forward to starting at University at the end of September; 26 students have been accepted at a Russell Group University.

It is a very exciting time for the students and I wish them every success in the coming years. Just to give you a flavour of the destinations that our students will be attending:

- Aston, Birmingham, Brunel, Cardiff, City, Coventry, De Montfort University Leicester, Glasgow, Kingston, Kings College London, Loughborough, Leeds, London School of Economics, Nottingham, Portsmouth, Queen Mary College, School of African and Oriental Studies, Southampton, Sussex, South Wales, University College London, Warwick, University Campus of Football Business.

Other students have secured or are looking for employment and some have chosen to take time out before continuing their studies or embarking on a career. I wish all of them every success in the coming years

It is a strength of Haydon that the majority of our students stay with us from Year 7 to Year 13. Parents can be confident that their son or daughter will be guaranteed high quality education throughout the crucial secondary years.
