It is with great pleasure and pride in our students and staff that I introduce the examination results for 2016. Ofsted praised Haydon for the “particularly positive relationships between teachers and students,” which “ensures an excellent climate for learning”.

This is clearly borne out again by our 2016 examination results. The Year 13 A-level and BTEC National results were excellent: 50% of grades were at A* to B and 72% at A* to C.



The total number of students going on to University in September 2016 currently stands at 182 including 55 to Russell Group Universities, the most challenging to get into. You can see the types of University courses our 2016 students are following within this booklet. In Year 12 the results were also outstanding. 39% of these results were awarded the highest grades of A and B. Our value added Year 12 results have been judged independently by ALPS as ‘Outstanding.’

At GCSE, 79% of students gained an A* to C in English and Mathematics and 72% of students gained 5 A* to C passes including English and Mathematics. 25% of all entries were graded A or A* and over 50% were graded A* to B. In Mathematics, 83% of students achieved A* to C and in English Language the figure was 86%.

It is a strength of Haydon that the majority of our students stay with us from year 7 to year 13. Parents can be confident that their son or daughter will be guaranteed high quality education throughout the crucial secondary years.

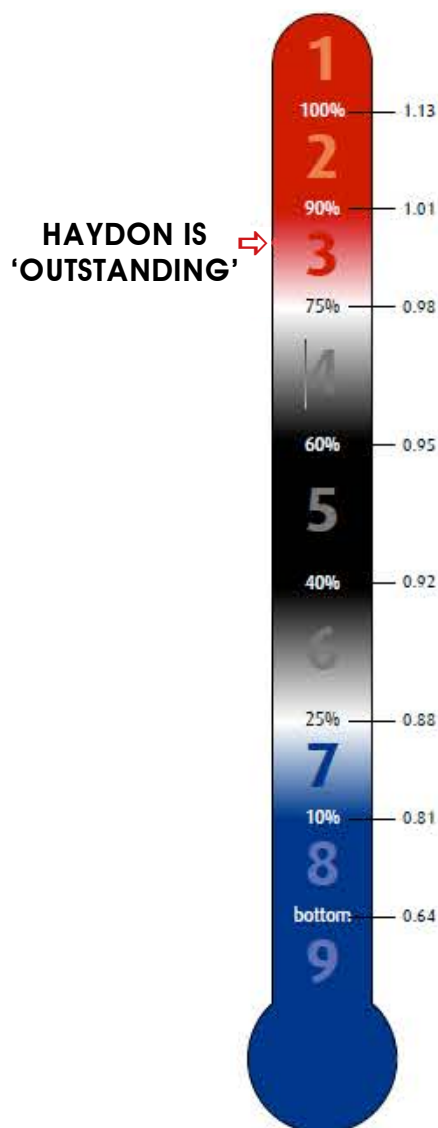

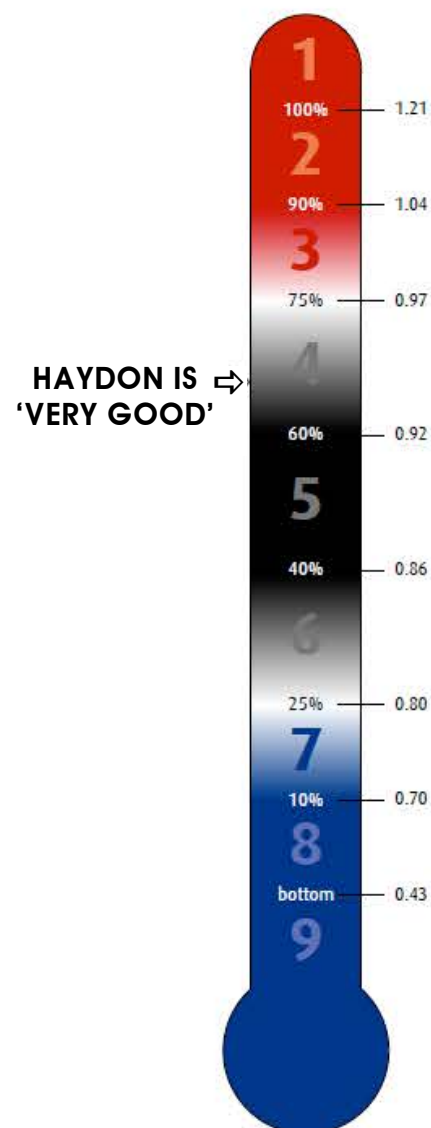

Haydon was ranked at Level 4 for both A Level and BTEC, meaning that students are making very good progress given their GCSE performance on entry to the Sixth Form. For AS Level, Haydon is ranked at Level 3, meaning students are making outstanding progress.
