PROPOSED PROJECTS

With your support we would like to work on the projects below:

Long-term Projects

Haydon Sports Centre

The Yellow Brick Road Fund proposes refurbishment of existing facilities to create a new Haydon Sports Centre with the changing rooms and sports hall made accessible to all. It will include a gym/fitness centre to be used by the school and the wider community locally and will allow an increased number of varied sports and permit outside clubs to use the facilities.



Undercroft Outdoor Space

The Yellow Brick Road Fund will bring together students in a more friendly and airy environment by redeveloping the Undercroft area of the school. It will be a multi-purpose space that includes seating and a communal food serving point, promoting healthy eating and socialising amongst the students.



Medium-term Projects

Air Conditioning

We would like to upgrade our sports facilities by adding air conditioning to our sports halls so that they can be flexibly used by students and offered to outside sports providers in all weather conditions.

LED Lighting

Our aim is to become energy efficient by replacing our lights with long-lasting and durable lights across the school site.

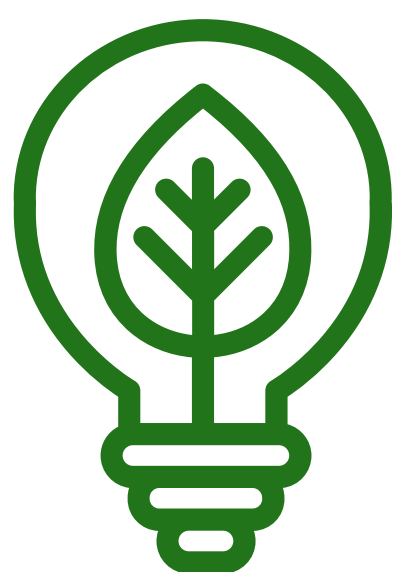
Short-term Projects

Rubbish & Recycling Bins
