

Year 12-Summer holiday homework- Art 2019

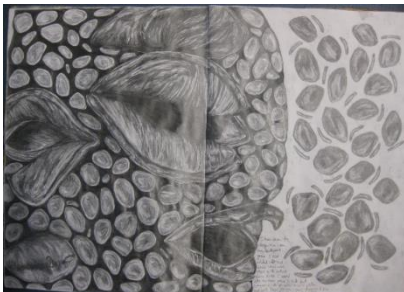
This homework is due in your first lesson back. If you are unsure of your timetable, please bring your homework on your first day at Haydon. Those who arrive without the homework being completed will be subject to a 50 minute imposition.

Welcome to Haydon School. Our first topic that we will be looking at is 'Tone and Texture.' Please ensure you have purchased an A3 art sketchbook from the Art department (£2) Over the summer you must have completed both homework 1 and 2.

Homework 1

A large tonal pencil *close up* drawing of an interesting textured object on pages 2-3 in your Haydon sketchbook.

Example:



How can I do well in homework 1?

A full range of tone has been used from dark to light

The object chosen has a detailed, bumpy texture

The drawing fills the whole of a double page

The object has been closely and accurately observed

A close up has been drawn, as opposed to the full object

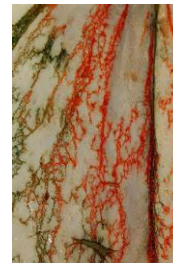
Highlights (light areas) are visible and may have been created using a rubber

There may be a sense of light direction on the object

Homework 2

20 photographs of different close up textures printed A6 on plain paper (not photographic paper) Images should be loose and not stuck into your sketchbook.

Examples:



How can I do well in homework 2?

Images must be A6

Images are well lit so textures are visible

Images are clear and not out of focus

There are a range of different textures and colours

Images are close ups, the edges of the objects are not visible

Images are not pixelated when printed

Images are not printed on shiny paper

Images are cut neatly with straight edges
