You took your friend's pencil case home by mistake. What would you do?

Your friend and you both want to go first in a game. What would you do?

The new pupil asks to sit with you to eat lunch. What would you do?

they beat you at football. What would you do?

Your friend decides they want to go to a lunch time club, but you don't want to go. What would you do?
