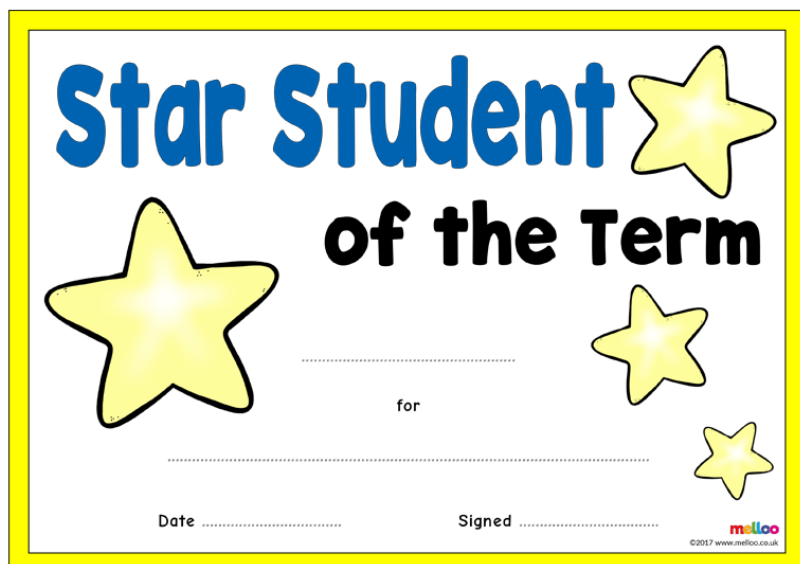
Students of the Term
