Building works and room changes

As you know, there is a lot of building work going on around the school. We have finished fitting solar panels to the roofs, and are now preparing the classrooms for eventually having air conditioning. This means that we will have to close some classrooms each week and move you elsewhere. The following rooms are closed next week and you will move to the below temporary classrooms, changes will appear on your timetable in Satchel:

- M205 to go to H002
- M206 to go to H111
- M214 to go to H112

When your form tutor reads this letter to you, they will make sure you know where the new rooms are and how to get to them. We have reopened the small corridor from St Nicks to the Hive, to help you move towards classrooms in the Hive.

Toilets

This is a gentle reminder that if you are found in a toilet cubicle with more than one person, you will be given an internal exclusion and your parents contacted. It is not appropriate to gather as large groups in the toilet, and it prevents other students from using the toilet when they genuinely need it.

Uniform

St Nicks Stairwell
