The Evening is a great opportunity for our Year 11 families to look at our Post16 provision and begin to make decisions about which subjects to take at A Level.

#### **Behaviour Review**

We were visited earlier this week by an external auditor, looking at behaviour in the school, and examining the impact of the changes we made to our behaviour policy towards the end of the year. Their feedback was overwhelmingly positive about behaviour at Haydon School, and they noted at the end of the day how impressed they had been by behaviour in lessons. They complemented teachers on the atmospheres created in classrooms to enable students to learn affectively, and reported to us that they had greatly enjoyed their time interviewing students about their experiences at Haydon School.

#### **Robotics Competitions**

Haydon's Sixth Form students are taking part in two robotics competitions this year. During half-term, they attended the launch events with Head of Computing, Mrs Dale. One event was held in Cambridge and the other was an online event which took place in school. At both events students were tasked with completing various challenges. During the launch events, students found out about the rules of the competitions, were given a basic launch pack and met the other teams involved in the competition. The student teams are now meeting regularly to design, build and programme their autonomous robot. It is fantastic to see the level of teamwork and problem solving that the teams are showing as they work towards their solutions. I would like to thank Ms Dale for supporting the students.

Mr Patel ran our 'UKMT Senior Maths Challenge 2023' for our budding Mathematicians in the sixth-form. This year, a total of eighteen students completed with five students qualifying for the next round. Many of our students are now studying Mathematics at Advanced Level. It is truly fantastic to see students taking time outside of their studies to compete in this National competition. Once again our students are demonstrating Haydon School values of Excellence and Perseverance. Noteworthy mentions to the five qualifiers from Year 13 who were: Isaac Algar, Yassine Birbiad, Manya Chowdhury, Molly Dorricott and Rayhan Zuberi and to everyone else who competed. Very well done!!

### <u>UKMT British Mathematical Olympiad Round 1 (November 2023)</u>

Special mention to Jonathan Ingram (Year 13) who automatically qualified and competed in the UKMT British Olympiad Round 1 following outstanding success in the initial 'Senior Maths Challenge Stage' in October. Manya Modi (Year 11) also participated in this Maths Olympiad. Thank You to Mr Patel for his support with our participating students.

### **Flood Resilience Project**

We are very pleased to announce that we are receiving a £350K grant to improve our flood resilience. Using this grant we will:

- improve drainage systems across the school site
- have 14 SuDS planters (sustainable drainage systems) to divert water from downpipe drains and use it to water plants in these planters
- build a rain garden in front of the admin block to reduce the surface water

The project is expected to finish by the end of April 2024.

#### **Solar Panels**

Our project of fitting solar panels on four of our roofs is progressing very well. Three of these roofs have now been producing electricity since October. To date we have saved 675 kg CO2 emission and this is equivalent to planting 41 trees. The project is planned to finish by the end of May 2024.


