Bursary

Students in Sixth Form who are eligible may apply for a bursary from 22nd September. The aim of the bursary fund is to support disadvantaged students with the costs of staying in education after the age of 16, (e.g. textbooks, equipment for practical subjects,

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educational trips, travel costs to school, university interviews and open days). Students have had a short presentation in assembly about the different types of bursary and eligibility.
